The aim of CISMA (the Cardiff Interactive Shoulder Movement Alliance) is to develop a standardised, clinical tool for the describing and recording of scapulothoracic position and movement patterns.

One of the unique aspects of the project is that the opinions of shoulder clinicians from around the world are being incorporated in the design and testing of the measurement tool, thus ensuring a truly democratic process. As the project is predominantly web-based it means that clinicians can participate in their own time, from the comfort of their home computer and with no cost.

We have active participation in the project from clinicians across five continents. However we are asking for the involvement of SPTS members so that their very valuable expertise can be incorporated into the tool development process.
